Thomas "Michael" Noel, 70, of Bloomington passed away on Wednesday, May 18, 2022 at his home after an extended illness.

He was born on March 5, 1952 in Bloomington, Indiana the son of Thomas Frederick and Madonna June (Chandler) Noel. Michael was a 1970 graduate of Bloomington High School South. He also attended Stockton Bible College in Stockton, California where he studied Theology.

Michael was an Apostolic Evangelist and Pastor of Clinton Apostolic Church in Clinton Indiana. In the early years Michael and his family traveled and made an album titled The Noel Family "Until He comes."

He enjoyed playing piano and painting he also was a great cook except for his concoction of Spanish eggs. He loved putting on church programs and would direct them like he was directing a show on Broadway.

Michael had a childhood with loving parents, his two sisters and a brother. When he heard his sisters say Thomas Michael! He knew he was in hot water.

Although he was troubled in his later years Micheal had such tremendous talent musically and in art. Sometimes Michael could be very dramatic but when he did something he did it with his whole heart.

With love our entire family would like to share the words to an old song "Turn your eyes upon Jesus look full in his wonderful face and the things of earth will grow strangely dim in the light of his glory and grace."

“ I was a student at the CAA school from January 1990 through May 1991. That was 2nd and 3rd grade for me. I'm not sure what other people's experiences of Pastor Noel were, and I certainly don't want to deny the validity of anyone else's lived experience. I remember Michael Noel as a gentle soul with a fun sense of humor. I remember being gently teased in a sermon (all in good fun) because I drew pictures of Super Mario Bros at the school. Television was frowned upon and video games probably were too, but they weren't very judgemental towards those who dissented from these guidelines. When I was caught cheating at the school, Mike had a conference with my dad and they explained the importance of not cheating in a way that stuck with me virtually my whole life. He also used to call me "Jack Flash," I think ironically because once when explaining my nickname he mimicked one of my slow mannerisms. As I remember the adults at that school modeled respect towards us, either by calling us sir/ma'am or calling us Mr/Miss so and so (I think the latter). I'm sad that I never got to reconnect with Mike as an adult. Last time I saw him was at an ecumenical style community sing along held at UPC in 1997 or 1998. I remember him commenting in jest that i was back visiting and that i was married (which was ridiculous of course because I was somewhere between 14 and 16 years old). That's my last memory of him.
