



Thomas "Tom" George Albright

Thomas G. Albright of Bloomington passed away on May 5, 2025, due to complications of Type-1 Diabetes. He was born in Wausau Wisconsin in 1953 to Leo and Helen Albright. He was preceded in death by his parents; his three brothers, Leroy, Gary, and Jim; and one nephew, Daniel. He was also preceded in death by his five truest life companions, his dachshunds, Honey Pie, Coffee Bean, Nutmeg, Peanut Butter, and Buster.

Tom left six nieces and nephews, twelve great nieces and nephews and one great-great nephew. Thomas completed his BA in Sociology and Anthropology in 1979 at the University of Wisconsin at Stevens Point, after which he came to Indiana University at Bloomington for graduate work in Cultural Anthropology and Human Sexuality where he studied under Dr. Paul H. Gebhard. During his graduate student years at Indiana University, Thomas taught courses in both Cultural Anthropology and the Anthropology of Human Sexuality as an associate instructor and was a graduate assistant at the Kinsey Institute.

He went on to work his entire career as a computer analyst/programmer at IT support provider at the Kinsey Institute and retired in 2018 after forty years at Indiana University and the Kinsey Institute.
