Thomas (Tomm) A. Vargas, 22, passed away on October 13, 2010 in San Jose, CA. Tomm was born on March 3, 1988 in Crawfordsville, IN, the son of Eileen J. Bewley of Indianapolis, and Walter A. Vargas, of Indianapolis. Tomm was a 2006 graduate of Pike High School, where he was a member of the band, which developed his life long love of music, playing both saxophone and guitar. Tomm was a full time student at De Anza College in Cupertino, CA, where he was majoring in Child Development. Tomm loved giving of himself and working with others. Working at Damar Inc. in Indianapolis and Camp Costanoan in Cupertino, CA, he was able to impact the lives of many young people. Tomm combined this passion with his love for biking, running, and outdoor activities by volunteering with the San Jose Bike Party, a community-unity effort. Tomm competed in both the Chicago and San Francisco marathons, several Indianapolis Mini Marathons, and was a regular participant in the Wheeler Mission Drum Stick Dash, as well as numerous other triathalons and fun runs. A diehard Colts fan, Tomm loved attending games and watching every game even while living in California. Tomm's easy-going and loving demeanor will be missed by all his friends and family.
