



Tommy Jay Curts

December 25, 1938 - June 12, 2024

Tommy Jay Curts, more commonly known as “Tom,” passed peacefully on June 12, 2024, in Carmel, but he was a Bloomington boy for most all his life. Tom was a Christmas baby, born in 1938 at Wabash, Indiana to Mary Helen Jay Curts and Ross Edward Curts.

Tom was a 1956 graduate of Bloomington High School and became a successful runner for the Panthers in both track and cross country, specializing in the mile run. After high school he attended the University of Colorado at Boulder on a track scholarship, where he graduated with a degree in aeronautical engineering.

Tom’s engineering career in the 60’s took him from California to Florida to Georgia to Texas and back to California during which time he worked for such companies as McDonnell Douglas, Lockheed, and General Dynamics. But Tom found his way back to Bloomington to raise his family and work as a car salesman, life insurance agent, auto parts department manager, project manager for an advertising firm and the owner of Crescent Donut.

Tom volunteered and served in various capacities in the Bloomington community including on the city’s Board of Zoning Appeals, as a youth baseball and basketball coach, as an active member and leader in the Christ Community Church, and as an officer of the Sherbrooke Condominium Association. He enjoyed playing basketball and tennis until he could no longer, so he developed a passion for golf that carried him through his later years. He was an avid IU sports fan.
