



Una Faye (Hawkins) Harmon

December 17, 1927 - January 23, 2015

Una Faye (Hawkins) Harmon, age 87 of Bloomington and Ellettsville Indiana passed away Friday afternoon January 23rd, 2015 at the Hearthstone Health Campus in Bloomington. She was born December 17th, 1927 in Bloomington, Indiana, attended University High School in the late 1930's and graduated from Edgewood High School in the early 1960's. She was the loving widow of Homer Harmon Jr.

Faye began her working life as a teenager during the Depression at RCA in the war effort section of the plant. She left RCA to have and care for her two boys John F. Harmon (Married to Peggy Pittman Harmon) and James B. Harmon (Married to Citrana Forgenie Harmon). After her sons began school Faye re-enrolled in High School at Edgewood High School in Ellettsville in order to get her high school diploma. Subsequently she worked as the Lunch Program Administrator for the Richland Bean Blossom School Corporation until retirement where to many students she was known as "The Lunch Lady". Faye was also active in the Stewart Community Tabernacle for many years.

Faye was preceded in Death by her Mother Esta Hawkins Paul, her Father John C. Hawkins, her husband Homer Harmon Jr., Sister Vernie Sexton and Brother Donald Hawkins. Faye leaves behind her two sons plus Granddaughters Macy Harmon Hughes, Lindsey Harmon, Maggie Harmon Parrish along with her sole great grandchild Mack Parrish, and an adopted granddaughter Yazmeen Maduro Harmon. Also surviving are siblings Ann Miller, Linda Latimer, Wanda Galyan and David Paul, son-in-laws Ross Hughes and Zack Parrish, along with many cherished nieces and nephews.
