



## Vera D. Brewer

February 12, 1940 - September 1, 2022

Vera D. Brewer, of Sandborn, died September 1, at her sister's home in Bloomington. She was 82. She was born in Greene County on Feb. 12, 1940, the last of six daughters of Dr. Stanley and Ollie Brewer, and grew up on the family farm near Pleasantville.

She graduated from Pleasantville High School, and earned a bachelor's degree in Biology and a master's degree in education from Indiana University-Bloomington. She was a biology teacher at Linton-Stockton High School in Linton, and later at White River Valley High School in Switz City.

She was preceded in death by her parents; three sisters, Wilma Pearce, Marjorie Hale and Donna Creek; and a nephew, Joe Hale. A sister, Dixie Lee Brewer, died at birth.

Surviving are: her sister, Doris Shoultz-Creek of Bloomington; four nieces, Glenda Schaefer of Vincennes; Debbie Kixmiller of West Terre Haute; Julie Creek of Fort Wayne, and Teresa Creek of Bloomington; a nephew, Jeffrey Creek of Bloomington, nine great-nieces and nephews; a step-great nephew, and 12 great-great nieces and nephews.
