Virgil Vernon Prince, 91 of Judah, Indiana, passed away Wednesday afternoon, July 31, 2024 at the Stonebridge Health Campus in Bedford, Indiana. He was born August 23, 1932 in Monroe County the son of Bee and Lila Prince of Chapel Hill, who have predeceased him. His parents had 11 children and Virgil was the last of the 11 children to pass away.

He was a United States Army Veteran having served during the Korean War from 1953 to 1955 as a Supply Depot Sergeant. Virgil married Beulah Grace in 1953 of Chapel Hill. Her parents were Clifford and Otha . Beulah passed away in 2010.

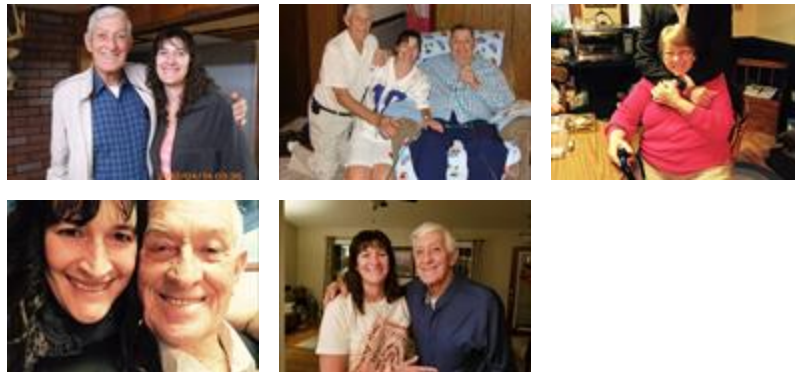
