



Virginia Lee Hudelson Rogers

August 14, 1927 - February 5, 2015

Virginia Lee (Hudelson) Rogers died Thursday, February 5, 2015 at her home in Bloomington.

Mrs. Rogers was born August 14, 1927 in Urbana, IL, the daughter of Robert and Willie Mae (Lightner) Hudelson. She married former State Senator David Rogers on November 24, 1956 and he preceded her in death a month ago, January 5, 2015. She was also preceded in death by her parents and her cousin, Sarah Lightner Koenig of Worthington, Ohio.

A 1945 graduate of Urbana High School, she attended the University of Illinois, graduating in 1948 with high honors. She then attended Indiana University and received an M.S. in Psychology in 1950.

She held several administrative positions at Indiana University including Director of Student Activities, Assistant Dean of Students, Dean of Women and Dean of Student Services. She also served as an Assistant to the President under President John W. Ryan.

She was a member of Psi Chi, Pi Lambda Theta, Alpha Lambda Delta and was an active lifelong member of Kappa Kappa Gamma, serving in many capacities for the IU chapter. She was president of

the IU Panhellenic Council and was the founder of the Mortar Board Honor Society at IU.

She is survived by her nieces, Ann Massing of Cambridge, England; Susan Houseworth of Champaign, Illinois; Jane Rogers Todd of Louisville, Kentucky; and a nephew, Michael Rogers of Bloomington.

Memorial services for Virginia will be held Friday February 13, 2015 at 1:00PM at Allen Funeral Home and Crematory 4155 South Old Highway 37. Visitation will be held also on Friday from 11:00AM until the time of the service at 1:00PM at Allen Funeral Home. Private burial will occur at Rosehill Cemetery immediately following.
