



## Virginia Lee Kleindorfer

October 9, 1933 - April 9, 2017

Virginia Lee Kleindorfer, age 83 of Bloomington passed away Sunday evening April 9, 2017, surrounded by her loving family, at Monroe Hospital. She was born in Anderson, Indiana on October 9, 1933 to Charles Leo Farmer and Florence Sauer Farmer.
