



Vivian Louise Haag

February 15, 1926 - February 12, 2025

Vivian Louise (Wilson) Haag died in Bloomington, Indiana on February 12, 2025, 3 days before her 99th birthday. Her final few days were made comfortable through the care of Heart to Heart Hospice. Born in Des Moines, Iowa February 15, 1926 to Raymond (Monk) Wilson and Erma Irene (Schwartzlander) Wilson, Vivian was a proud Iowan. A celebration and memorial will be held on April 2, 2025 at 11 a.m. at Westminster Presbyterian Church, 4114 Allison Ave, Des Moines, Iowa. The family will greet and share memories with family and friends starting at 10:00 a.m. On April 3, at 9:30 a.m. an interment will be held at the Iowa Veteran's Cemetery.

Vivian was a proud graduate of Abraham Lincoln High School in Des Moines, Iowa where she later worked in the school office. She worked at Braniff Airways where she met her husband of 61 years, Clyde Haag. They were married on February 14, 1956. Vivian's later career combined her love of politics and words, when she worked in the Iowa Legislature, and retired from the Iowa Code Editor's Office. After retirement, Vivian traveled, read, dove deeper into genealogy, debated politics and world affairs, continued her decade's long practice of keeping journals, enjoyed her friends and relished her role as grandparent and great-grandparent. She was an active member of Park Avenue Presbyterian, Windsor Presbyterian and Westminster Presbyterian Churches.

Vivian was preceded in death by her husband Clyde Haag in 2018, her parents, and brothers James (Marilyn, who survives) Wilson, Raymond (Colleen) Wilson and Ralph (Marilyn) Wilson. Surviving Vivian are her daughter Melinda S. Haag (Jane E. Barker), James J. Haag (Lori L. Haag), grandchildren Amanda M. Haag, Jordon J. Haag and Anne W. Barker, great-granddaughter, Jamie V. Haag, as well as cousins, nieces, nephews and dear friends.
