Wanda Jackson, 87, of Bloomington passed away at her home on the 6th of November 2011.

Wanda was the first of six children born to George Powell Ferree and Zella P. Felknor Ferree Hamilton on the 30th of July 1924, in Bloomington.

She was a graduate of Bloomington High School and married her high school sweetheart Raymond Jackson, the son of Frank and Emma Amanda (Mullis) Jackson, on the 3rd of October 1942.
