



Warren "Ted" Lorenzen

April 26, 1931 - July 27, 2016

Warren Theodore "Ted" Lorenzen died at home July 27, 2016. Born April 26, 1931 in Hackensack, New Jersey, he was the only child of Donald Lorenzen and Isabelle (Winand) Lorenzen.

Ted graduated high school in 1948 from Onondaga Valley Academy in Syracuse, New York. Following a brief stint in the U.S. Naval Reserves, Ted enlisted in the United States Air Force in 1949. He served three years with distinction, stationed in Yokahama, Japan. His patriotism and pride in service to his country never left him.

Following his return stateside, Ted was stationed at Chanute Field in Champaign, Illinois where he met his future wife of 61 years, Patricia Wills...a farmer's daughter. They were married January 29, 1954. Their years together took them to many locations: Yakima, Washington; Bloomington, Illinois; Syracuse, New York; Shakopee, Minnesota and finally to Bloomington, Indiana; with five children born (coast - to - coast!) along the way.
