Wilford Buel "Togo" Acuff, 79, of Bloomington, passed away on Tuesday, August 7, 2018, at IU Health Bloomington Hospice House. He was born on April 14, 1939 in Stinesville, Indiana; the son of George and Beryl (Canada) Acuff.

Wilford graduated from Ellettsville High School and attended Indiana University. He married Donna Kay Underwood on September 22, 1963 at the Clear Creek Christian Church. Wilford began his career in 1959 with Sarkes Tarzian Manufacturing, Tuner Division, Employment history included positions with local manufactures, including Online Plastics, his favorite job however, was being an AmeriCorps Vista volunteer with Area 10 in Ellettsville.
