



## Winfred "Buck" Prince

July 12, 1932 - March 19, 2011

Winfred Harold "Buck" Prince, 78, of Springville died Saturday morning at the University of Louisville Hospital from injuries suffered in an automobile accident. Born July 12, 1932 in Smithville, Indiana, he was the son of Emery Prince and step mother Maude, and mother May Morron and step father Bracie. Buck was a United States Army veteran, serving during the Korean War. He spent his professional career as a crane operator in limestone mills including Indiana Limestone, Woolery's and Independent Limestone. He retired from Independent Limestone in 1993. He was a member of the Eagles Local 1085, the VFW Post 9107, and was a member of the Laborers Union 741 for 50 years. Throughout his life Buck was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed time hunting, fishing. He also enjoyed a wide variety of other sports especially NASCAR. and Marshall Morron, as well as three sisters Maxine Arthur, Roberta Morron, and Rose Marie Prince.
