She was preceded in death by her parents; spouse, Elso Pacific; son, John Pacific; and siblings, Shiro and Kazuko.

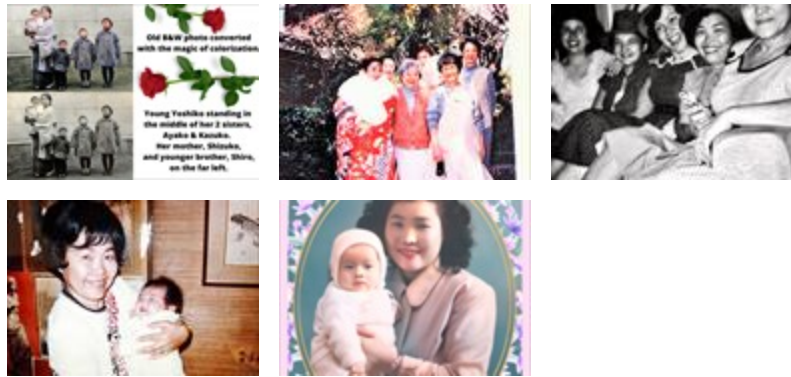

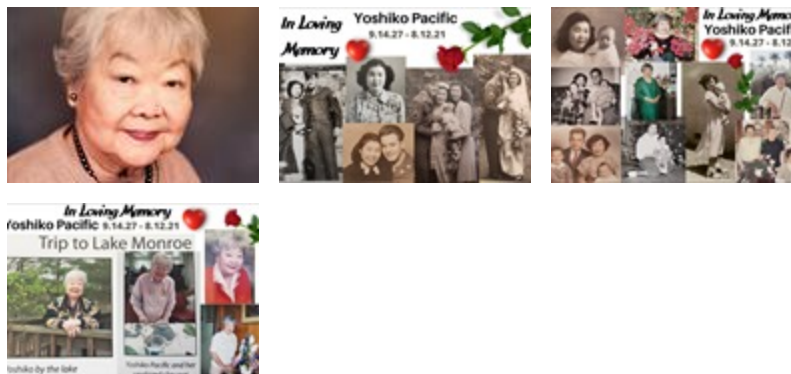
